Re: Head Lice

Unfortunately we have had a couple of cases of head lice recently.

Please could I stress to Parents the importance of tying back long/shoulder length hair and checking your child's hair on a regular basis. If you should find any lice or eggs please could you treat immediately and keep treating until all the eggs are cleared.

The best treatment is simply combing hair with a lice comb and hair conditioner or olive oil. If everyone could do this on a weekly basis it would help – we know how frustrating it is for Parents to treat their children only for the problem to return days later. Make Fridays 'Bug Busting Day'.

There are also plenty of products on the market and advice can be sought from your pharmacist.

Thank you for taking the time to read this letter and hopefully we can reduce the incidents as much as is possible.
