

Reading

- Bible stories - answering reading comprehension questions based on parables.
- Balanced Arguments - preparing arguments, debating and reading examples.
- Letters - identify the features and making comparison between letters.

Assessment - Children will be assessed during book talk sessions and reading comprehension activities.

Writing

This term children will focus on three exciting extended writing pieces, planning, writing and evaluating their work. These will include the following:

- Adventure narrative - retelling the journey of Moses
- Balanced arguments
- Formal letter writing

Assessment/outcome - Children will produce three interesting, extended pieces of writing. The children will also apply and use their writing skills in other subject areas.

Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar

Spelling Bee investigations will take place weekly during school time and children will be responsible for a spelling book in school to aid their spelling practise.

Year 3 and 4

- Suffixes & prefixes
- Inverted commas
- Conjunctions
- Adverbs
- Fronted adverbials

Mental Arithmetic

- Number - number and place value
- Number - addition and subtraction
- Calculate multiplication and division problems

Assessment - Children will be tested weekly on their times tables knowledge.

Mathematics

- Number and place value - addition and subtraction using formal written methods
- Multiplication and division - focus on 3,4 and 8 times tables.

Assessment - Pupils will be continually assessed throughout lesson time and given appropriate next steps and feedback promptly.
